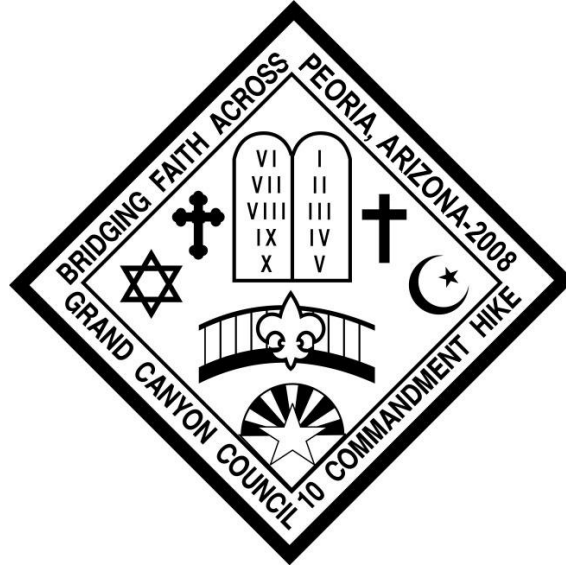


# TEN COMMANDMENT HIKE – 2008

(The Friday after Thanksgiving)

The Ten commandment hike is open to all youth in Scouting, their siblings and family, and other groups along with their leader and friend. The 2008 Ten Commandment Hike will take place in Peoria, AZ.

The hike will begin at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and is located on the Southeast corner of 79<sup>th</sup> Ave and West Acoma Drive. Take the Thunderbird Road exit from the AZ-101 state highway and travel east one mile to 79<sup>th</sup> Ave. At the stop light, turn left and the church is ½ mile north on your right.

Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. The hike fee is \$5.00 per youth and adult, which includes an event patch as depicted above. All participants must register and pay their fees before beginning the hike for insurance purposes.

We hike as a single group to each religious stop in the order of the Ten Commandments. You

will be greeted by a presenter at each stop who will discuss a Commandment, their religion and House of Worship and finally answering some questions.

All participants must provide their own lunch and this stop will occur midway through the hike. There are no stores available to make purchases. Soft drinks, water and cookies will be served, courtesy of the Interfaith Religious Committee.

All hikers must bring and carry their own water. Water refill stations will be available throughout the hike.

The hike ends around 4:00 p.m., back where we began. Small children are always welcomed and they are free. It is strongly recommended you bring a stroller or wagon to transport them. Our time is divided between sitting and walking.
