

Family Fest May 2nd 2009

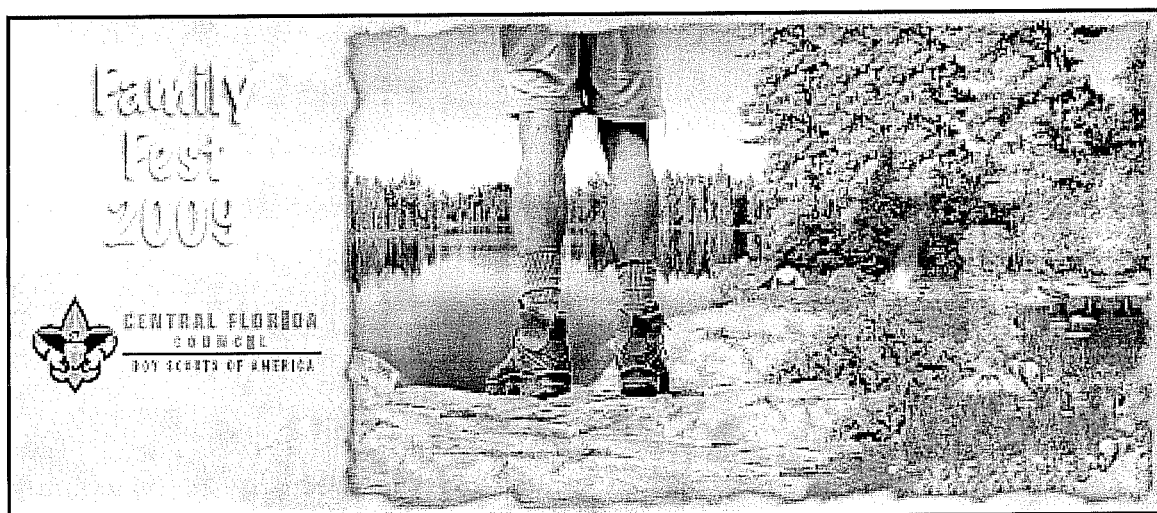
On May 2nd, 2009 the Boy Scouts of America in the Apopka area will be having an event known as Family
