Shooting Sports

Shooting Sports (Archery and/or BB Guns) are conducted under the Boy Scouts of America certified Range Operators following the prescribed guidelines from the National Council for Health and Safety. Each pack participates in a safety orientation that insists the concept that youth **DO NOT TOUCH GUNS WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION** in a controlled environment. After the orientation they can use the bow and/or BB gun to practice the safety instruction while under BSA Certified adult supervision. Tiger Scouts are REQUIRED to have an adult partner with them while on the range. **NO TIGER WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOOT WITHOUT ADULT PARTNER.**
