

Scout Uniform -Class-A

Pack 321 requires a full uniform for all Cub Scouts. This is the one way all Scouts are alike. Whenever a Scout sees another Scout in uniform he knows he is like that person because both have committed to the principles of the Scout Promise and Scout Law.

The scouts and leaders should wear their uniforms to all Pack meetings, den meetings, Roundtable, and outings. Uniforms are not required for activities like camping activities that may cause damage to the uniform. For these types of activities, we encourage the use of class-B uniforms instead.

Scouts in Pack 321 buy their own uniform, including general patches. The pack provides advancement badges. Pack 321 accepts any dark blue pants or shorts worn with the appropriate shirt. All shirts should be tucked in and in good condition.

Uniforms can be bought at Longs, located downtown in Hutchinson. Consider giving outgrown or unwanted uniforms back to our pack, after removing your scout's advancement badges, for other scouts to use.

All awards such as rank badges, arrow points, belt loops, etc. are purchased by the pack and presented at Pack meetings.

 - "321" Unit Number Patch(es)
- Blue Belt with Cub Scout Buckle



Webelos Scout Uniform

- Tan Scout Shirt

 - Patrol Emblem

 - "321" Unit Number Patch(es)
 - Blue Shoulder Loops
- Blue Belt with Webelos Buckle (preferred)
- Webelos Colors (Highly recommended)



Leaders Uniform

All Cub Scout and Boy Scout adult leaders wear the same uniform with colored shoulder loops. Blue loops indicate affiliation with a Cub Scout pack and red loops indicate affiliation with a Boy Scout troop.

- Yellow or Tan Scout Blouse (Women)
 - World Crest Patch
 - Den Number Strip or Patrol Emblem
 - Badge of Office

- Olive Belt with Boy Scout Buckle (Tan Shirt)
- Blue Belt with Cub Scout Buckle (Yellow Shirt)
- Leaders or Other Neckerchief (optional)
- Scarf for Yellow Blouse (optional)
- Hat - same as above (optional)



Class-B Uniform

Class-b uniforms are used for camping and other outdoor activities that may cause damage to the Class-a uniform. They are basically a heavy duty t-shirt with our own custom pack design. Please ask your leader how to obtain one.
