

Day Camp

Cub Scout Day Camp offers a fun-filled week of challenging Cub Scout activities, exciting adventures and new friendships. It is open to boys entering grades 1 -5. Day. Opening ceremonies start the day at 9:00 a.m. and camp closes at 3:30 p.m.



Cub Scouts will participate in many types of activities including water activities, archery, BB's, field sports, nature, arts and crafts, Scouts skills and a variety of other events.

Activities - All areas (especially archery, BB's and water activities) place a special emphasis on safety procedures. Each week has a Family Day complete with awards and a ceremony in the afternoon. Cub Scout advancement is included in the program although we "disguise" it as part of the fun! Safe fun is the main goal of camp!

Fees - An individual registration form and health form will need to be filled out along with the payment for camp. The fee for camp is due at the time of registration. Checks should be made out to Yankee Clipper Council.

(You might even have fun yourself!) - To insure a successful Day Camp program for our Cub Scouts, volunteers are needed at camp to assist the staff and guide the Cubs through each day's activities. Volunteers will need to complete a Volunteer Application and Medical Form and submit with your son's Day Camp registration and Medical Form.

A special "Tot Lot" program area is available, at no charge, for volunteers who need to bring siblings to camp. The area is staffed by a responsible adult and staff who have planned activities for the children.
