Belt Loop & Pin Requirements

- Belt loops and pins are earned only by Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts, and Webelo Scouts (not adults).
- Requirements may be adjusted to accommodate the special needs of boys with disabilities.
- Scouts may earn an award more than once; however, leaders should encourage boys to try different requirements and earn the pin.
- Webelo Scouts may earn a belt loop or pin a second time to qualify for Webelo activity badges.
- Pack 108 policy limits awards to two belt loops and pins per month.
- Awards presented by Pack 108 must be earned while the boy is a registered Cub Scout with the Pack.

There are 17 subject areas in the Academics program and 23 subject areas in the Sports Program.
