## **Cub Scout Pack 108 Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions**

### **Popcorn Sale – Oct/Nov.**

The popcorn sale is the main fundraiser for Pack 108. Help coordinate the fund drive which kicks off during the October Pack Meeting. A couple of volunteers are needed help with logistical planning, to help coordinate pickup/delivery and manage the awards/prizes that are associated with the fundraiser.

### **Hospitality – Ongoing**

Pack 108 serves refreshments at all regular pack meetings. Volunteers are needed to purchase food, beverages, utensils, cups, etc. Refreshments get setup during the beginning of the meeting and they need to be cleaned up before leaving the Parish Hall. We have large coffee pots that belong to the pack that can be used and a closet that has some space available for stocking extra supplies.

### **Halloween Party – October Pack Meeting**

Every year Pack 108 has a Halloween Costume party at the October Pack meeting. Scouts and parents are invited to come in a costume. Volunteers are needed to buy, setup & cleanup food, refreshments, games and any crafts. The committee needs to coordinate the procurement of materials etc. to build the crafts/games and to man stations during the event.

### **Christmas Party - December Pack Meeting**

Our December pack meeting is a Christmas Party. We need volunteers to help plan this meeting. This includes food and refreshments and may involve crafts & games. The committee will need to identify the crafts to be made by the scouts, coordinate the procurement of materials etc. to build the crafts and to man craft stations during the meeting.

### **Pinewood Derby -**

Cars distributed during November meeting. Several volunteers are needed to help with the Pinewood Derby. Committee members are needed to fill the following positions: setup, decorations, registration/weigh in, repair station, set up crew, clean up crew, race official, refreshments and cleanup.

### **Blue and Gold Banquet - February**

The Blue & Gold Banquet is the highlight of the scouting year and is the time for scouts to be proud of their accomplishments. Tasks include finding and booking a place for the dinner (if not in the Parish Hall), deciding upon a theme for the evening, finding guest speakers, coordinating a caterer, decorations, clean up, etc. We have a coordinator this year, but she will need help with decorations and set up.

### **Service Projects Planning - On Going**

We are looking for a volunteer to take responsibility for managing Pack 108 service projects throughout the year. Service projects include a Wayne park cleanup or school trail improvement project (Oct), Thanksgiving Food Drive (Nov) and Scouting for Food (Mar). We are looking for a volunteer to help coordinate these events and to explore additional ways to serve our community.

### **Special Events, Outings, and Camping**

Volunteers are needed to help keep the "Outing" in Scouting. We are always looking for ideas and coordinators for field trips and campouts. Some past ideas include: West Point tour & football game, Christmas caroling at a local hospital, hiking trips, kite fly, winter snow tubing, circus, etc.
