✪ CUB SCOUT RESIDENT CAMP

Resident Camp is a great experience for all Scouts entering the 1st through 5th grades in the fall of 2009. This is an overnight program that provides Cub Scouts with experiences they can only get at Cub Resident Camp at Camp Lewis. This unique program has Scouts arriving for Camp on Saturday and departing on Wednesday night.

Fees:

Troop Camping Fee = \$320 per week; \$290 per week before May 1st

Provisional Fee = \$370 per week; \$340 per week before May 1st

Leaders Fees = The first 2 leaders are free with 8 paid scouts. 1 additional leader is free for every paid 8 scouts. A \$125 fee is charged for each leader exceeding this ratio. Troops with less than 8 paid scouts will be charged \$125 for each leader. *Certified Webelos Crossover attend at early discount rate.*

★ **HIGH ADVENTURE**

The ultimate site for High Adventure, Floodwood Mountain Scout Reservation is perfect for your older Scouts and Venturers! Every Scout must be at least 13 years old by January 1, 2009. There is a maximum of 8 crews per week, 11 participants per crew. Every participant youth and adult pay the participant fee.

NOTES TO ALL CAMP PROGRAMS

CAMPERSHIPS

A Scout should not miss out on the summer camp experience due to lack of funds. The Northern New Jersey Council provides Campership funds to assist Scouts and their families with a portion of the camp fees. Campership applications are available through the Council Service Centers. For those applying for a campership please register as any Scout but indicate “applying for a Campership” on the application. Please do not send any money with the Campership application. Keep in mind that due to limited funds, Camperships do not cover 100% of the fees, so plan your budget accordingly. Campership requests only cover one week of camp. Campership applications must be received by April 13, 2009.

PAYMENTS & REFUNDS

There are **NO DEPOSITS** for any camp programs; fees are only accepted, in full, on a first-come basis. Partial fees will be returned and the Scout will not be registered. There is a non-refundable cancellation fee of \$100 for **each** registered program or session. **After May 31st, refunds are issued for valid medical reasons only.** All refund requests must be made in writing no later than August 31, 2009. No refund requests will be considered after August 31, 2009.
