Attendance Award



Starting in the 2008 – 2009 Year of Scouting, we will institute a program recognizing Cubs who strive for good attendance to Pack and Den events. We realize that the Cubs will be involved in multiple activities and that, sometimes, life happens and the Cub will not be able to attend an event. Therefore, the following guidelines for our Pack Good Attendance Award have been instituted with that thought in mind.

To earn the attendance award,
A Scout can not miss more than:

- ✂ One regularly scheduled Pack meeting during the program year (September through August).
- ✂ Two regularly scheduled Den meetings during the program year (September through August).

A Scout must also,

- ✂ Attend and participate in the Pack Pinewood Derby
- ✂ Attend the Pack Blue & Gold Dinner
- ✂ Participate in the annual Popcorn Sale fundraiser
- ✂ Attend at least one Camping trip **** see note below**
- ✂ Attend at least 2/3rd of special Den activities/outings
- ✂ Attend at least 2/3rd of special Pack activities/outings

Other Information:

- ✂ The awards will be presented at the first Pack meeting of the program year, so this year's will be awarded in September, 2009. We will, however, recognize the Webelos at the last Pack meeting of the year this spring or the first of the next year.
- ✂ The Official BSA Insignia Guide simply says the award is worn on the official uniform above the left pocket. It does not give a distance above. I would put it about the same height as the Service Star. Let the year bars dangle on the pocket flap.

** The Pack will strive to have at least two overnight outings per calendar year. In the event that we do not, any District or Council sponsored overnighter will count towards the award. This includes Halloween at Beaumont, Klondike and District Campouts if they are offered.
